<u>Legacy Options High School Letter of Essential Information (LOLOEI)</u>

As we approach the end of our 2nd Trimester, which ends on Friday February 22, 2019, we are asking all of our students to ensure they are current with all assignments and make-up work has been turned in. Parents / Guardians please consider speaking with your student(s) about the status of their course work. Legacy Options will be providing Unit Recovery Course work to assist our students. The following information is a brief overview of the 2nd Trimester Unit Recovery program.

<u>Ten Day – 2nd Trimester Unit Recovery:</u>

Unit recovery is a real time intervention aimed at preventing course failure for the 2nd Trimester. Students who are finishing their course with an overall percentage of 49%-59% are encouraged to retake 1-2 units to complete/pass the class. Students, who need to complete more than two units or have a percentage of less than a 49%, may want to consider taking the course in credit recovery, summer school, or the following school year.

Students in danger of failing their course(s) will be directed towards the appropriate standard, unit, topic, or skill recovery process on Edgenuity, or a teacher designed unit. Once the assigned unit, topic, standard or skill related assignment has been mastered, or completed, their current course grade should adjust accordingly. Students will be responsible for completing the work outside of normal class time. As a part of their unit recovery contract, we may require they attend after school tutoring on Thursdays during the Unit Recovery Period. If students do not complete the expectations of the Unit Recovery contract, their grade will be an F for the course.

A Unit Recovery Contract will be provided to each student that meets the Unit Recovery requirements. Should a student elect to participate in the Unit Recovery Window, the parent / guardian will need to sign the contract along with the student, and return to school counselor Ms. Maria Wright.

We are asking all of our students to be on time for school and to come ready to learn each day. A major emphasis of Legacy Options High School for the entire year will be on daily attendance. At Legacy Options, we strongly feel that for our students to be successful, daily attendance is a critical factor. Students, parent(s) / guardian(s), for the reporting periods listed, attendance is below 80% and below school weekly attendance goal of 95%.

The following information is provide to clarify the Denver Public School Policy on student absence. In order for an absence to be excused a Parent/guardian must call the school secretary at (720-424-3100) when a student is absent. Notification must be provided when the student returns to school by a written note, doctor's note, or other documentation within 48 hours of the absence. The Principal has the final say in whether or not an absence is excused. If a student is absent for three days or more, a doctor's note must be provided. It is the student's responsibility to contact each teacher and arrange for make-up assignments. Students missing classes for excused absences, suspension, or school business related absences are NOT excused from completing class work. Extenuating circumstances around attendance should be discussed directly with school administration.
